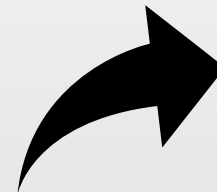

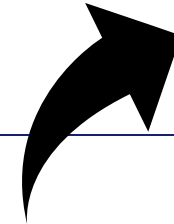

THE ONLINE APPLICATION

1. WHEN IS THE DEADLINE FOR APPLICATIONS TO THE ERASMUS CALL 24-25?

Applications open on 9 February 2024, 8:30 am, and close on 29 February 2024, 1 pm. To avoid technical issues, we encourage you not to wait until the last moment.

2. HOW CAN I APPLY?

You have to apply online following [this link](#).

The International Mobility Office created some useful [Guidelines to the online application](#) for you to apply correctly. We encourage you to read them carefully *before* you start the application process.

Students with disabled matriculation number that are waiting to enrol to a Master's degree and students with a double enrolment have to contact the International Mobility Office via InformaStudenti to have instructions on application procedures.

3. I REALISED I MADE A MISTAKE FILLING THE FORM: CAN I CHANGE IT?

Yes, the application can be amended before submission. Once the application is submitted, it can not be modified. However, it is possible to cancel the submitted application and create a new one before the final deadline!

4. IF I CANNOT FIND ANY AVAILABLE DESTINATIONS DURING THE APPLICATION PROCEDURE, WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

If this is the case, it means that no positions are available for your course.

5. WHICH DOCUMENTS SHOULD I PREPARE BEFORE I START MY APPLICATION?

- a valid identity document (ID/Driving licence/passport: PDF
- CV and transcript of records from current and previous studies: PDF
- [Form 1](#) (Learning Agreement proposal): PDF
- a certificate stating the knowledge of the working language(s) (a single PDF) (recognised by UniMi/SLAM/self-declaration when foreseen by the Call). Please read paragraph 4 of the Call carefully.
- any other document you think will be useful for your selection: PDF, max 5MB.

6. HOW EXACTLY CAN I CERTIFY MY "PREVIOUS STUDIES"?

Previous studies should be attached as part of your CV in a single PDF document, and should be certified as follows:

- Bachelor's and single-cycle Students: current Transcript of Records, which should show all the exams passed at the time of application (you can download it from UNIMIA);
- Master's Students: proof of previous studies; previous degree and exams taken in previous studies and Transcript of Records; if you studied at Unimi before, you can download this document from UNIMIA.

7. HOW MANY AND WHICH DESTINATIONS CAN I CHOOSE?

You may select up to *three* Universities (1 compulsory and 2 optional), between the destinations shown during the application procedure. Please note that the order in which candidates list destinations in their application represents a binding order of priority to generate the ranking list. Students of "Data science and economics" and "Biotechnology (K06)", whose agreements include several fields of study, can only apply for one of the two areas.

- **Sorbonne** (Paris):

In past years, managing the exchange at Sorbonne has been quite challenging, both in terms of response times and the process of defining the course offerings. They use hard deadlines!

Often, the Learning Agreements had to be revised multiple times due to changes in the courses available.

It is not clear whether this situation is the norm or an isolated case; therefore, it is highly recommended to verify the current procedures, schedules, and available courses.

WHERE? Some notes (about past years)

- **Copenhagen:**

Past data shows that the number of undergraduate courses taught in English is very limited (around 7 courses), while there is a much broader offering at the master's level (about 80 courses).

However, in past years undergraduate students are not allowed to take master's-level courses unless they have earned around 120 ECTS credits, which is often not feasible before the end of the third year.

For this reason, it might be useful to plan ahead, for example by leaving your 12 free credits (ECTS) for use during the mobility. You will still need at least 2 other courses with direct equivalence in order to have an acceptable Learning Agreement (considering that Copenhagen courses are worth 7.5 ECTS).

- **Greek Universities (University of the Aegean):**

past course websites and teaching plans may still be online, but not updated. It is crucial to verify the most recent academic offerings, as previously listed courses might have changed or may no longer be available

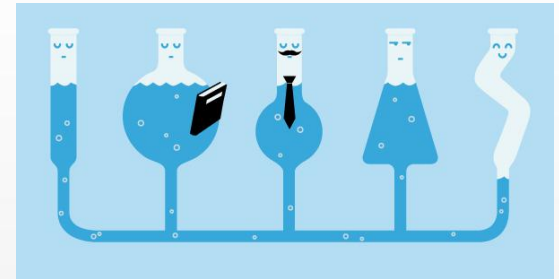
How to choose the courses

- Only 12 credits are elective (if not already spent in your study plan), here you have more freedom of choice. Foreign exams become your “**elective exams**” up to a TOTAL (UNIMI-Abroad) of 12 credits. (DSE students has a different max. number!)
 - If you find two abroad courses of 7,5+7,5 ECTS that are your elective credits, you can exceptionally increase the number of free credits to 15CFU, **but you still have to get 180-12 or 120-12 of non-elective remaining credits**. In case, ask your reference teacher about this.
- The remaining credits (e.g., $30-12=18$) should correspond as closely as possible to the corresponding UNIMI exams at the program level.
 - Examples:
Bases de datos, 12 CFU → Database Basics,
12 CFU Operating systems, 12 CFU → Operating Systems, 12 CFU



How to choose the courses

- Pay attention to the modules that are difficult to combine with our 6-credit exams (e.g., 2, 4, 7, 7.5 credits).
 - In this case, it is necessary to **compose enough exams and programs to cover the exams of your study plan** that you want to have recognized upon your return.



Examples

- **6** courses of 5 ECTS (6x5) to map **5** UNIMI courses of 6 CFU (5x6)
- **4** courses of 7,5 ECTS (4x7,5) to map 5 UNIMI courses of **6** CFU (5x6)
- 6+3+3 to map a UNIMI course of 12 CFU
- etc.

- It is necessary that in Module 1 everything is clear, and that the correspondences are truly FEASIBLE (for semester, requirements, language, etc.) with our courses that are in the study plan. **Module1 should be similar to your future LA**
- Pay attention to the elective credits, there are only 12, if not already used

In «Guidelines to the online application»

Read the destination details carefully. They will help you identify key elements such as the duration (which cannot be changed), the number of places available, the subject area (ISCED code) based on the Bilateral Agreement that was signed, and any relevant notes.

For semester-long destinations, you will be asked to select the semester (first or second). This choice is free, but it needs to be taken consciously, depending on personal needs, on the period in which the courses of your interest are offered and on other possible academic necessities. Only in exceptional cases will it be possible to change this choice after your selection.

It is necessary to confirm through “Add destination” the data entered. Repeat the steps mentioned above for each new destination you want to add.

You can select your preferred destinations, up to 3.
Please check the entry requirements and the application's deadlines on the websites of partner universities before choosing them.
Please also consult the academic offer and the working language.

Extensions of the stay period

- If a student leaves for the **first semester**, they may try to request an extension of their stay, but authorization is not guaranteed.
- Approval must be obtained
 - from the host university
 - through UNIMI's mobility office,
 - a new Learning Agreement must already have been agreed upon with their Erasmus contact.
- If departing for the **second semester**, can I extend my period?
 - Only until September (it does not extend into the following Academic Year).



Courses abroad: Increase of the final grade



- The increase in the graduation grade for international mobility, **which includes both exams and thesis**, is determined by the sum of the quality and quantity of work done during the period, **with a maximum possible increase of +3 points.**
- **Quantity**
 - At least 24 ECTS (European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System) credits obtained during 1 academic semester: 0.5 points
 - At least 48 ECTS credits obtained during 2 academic semesters: 1.0 point
- **Quality (if at least 21 ECTS credits are earned in international mobility):**
 - From 18/30 to 23.999/30: 0.5 points
 - From 24/30 to 25.999/30: 1.0 point
 - From 26/30 to 27.999/30: 1.5 points
 - From 28/30 and above: 2.0 points

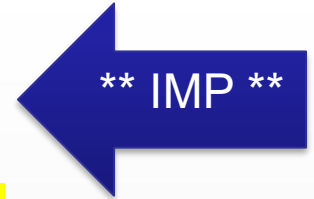
Thesis Abroad:

- In this Call, it is also possible to undertake theses within the external host university (see also the Call for “Theses Abroad”)
 - For external theses, refer to the Traineeship Call, which deals with the possibility of carrying out a training internship abroad at companies, research and training centers, or other organizations. The student must independently check if the selected computer science locations allow for theses.
- **ATTENTION! It is the student's responsibility to identify (and contact) the foreign professor to supervise the thesis**
 - Evaluate, at the foreign location, laboratories, professors, courses, and skills in relation to one's own degree course and thesis interests. It is also necessary to identify a possible internal supervisor in our department.



Thesis Abroad: what you need

- It is not necessary to have the exact thesis title, but the more detailed the educational plan, the better! It is very important to already be in contact (indicate names and emails)
 - with the foreign professor who is willing to supervise the thesis
 - and with a supervisor from Unimi who will coordinate the activity.

Thesis Abroad: requirements

- If you have not,
 - A name of a professor in the destination university willing to advise you
 - A title or at least a defined topic
 - An agreement on how many credits of thesis work will be done abroad
 - An UNIMI reference teacher
 - Emails/Documents to attach to the application to prove all the above



It will be difficult to win a position requesting a thesis abroad.

- In case, you can consider apply for the first semester, and if, and only if, you get the above requirements, you can ask to extend you staying for other 6 months to do the thesis (not sure to be approved).



Thesis Abroad: Increase of the final grade

- The increase is the sum of the components of quality and quantity of work during the period (**max +3 points**).
- **Quality**
 - Measures the excellence of the internship activity as evaluated by the professor at the host university who supervised the student, who will formulate an assessment according to the following scale:
 - sufficient: 0.5 points;
 - good: 1 point;
 - very good: 1.5 points;
 - excellent: 2 points.
- **Quantity**
 - Measures the volume of study, according to the following criteria:
 - for the final internship of the bachelor's degree: 0.5 points;
 - for the final internship of the master's degree: 1 point.

Erasmus Increase

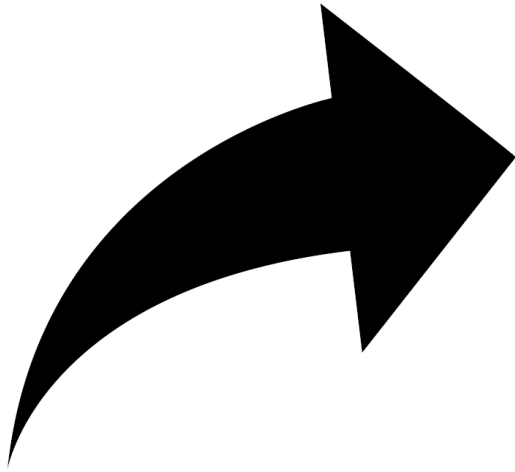

REPLACEMENTS

- Vacant Eligible students who were not selected for any destination will be put on the waitlist for each destination they were eligible for.
- After the first window for acceptance is closed, the online platform will generate a new ranking, reassigning any vacant places to eligible students on the waitlist. Students, summoned by ranking order, may choose whether to accept or waive a vacant destination within the second acceptance window. The students will be informed of the dates of this second acceptance window.
- Students on the waitlist can be called until **July 16, 2025**.
- Selected students who withdraw from the assigned destination will not be considered for their second or third choices.
- If a student on the waitlist is offered a destination on their application and they do not accept it, they will not be reconsidered for other destinations.

- Selected students who withdraw from the assigned destination will not be considered for their second or third choices.

- 4EU+: Building a European University, involving nearly 300,000 students and over 26,000 teachers and researchers. Campuses that have active exchanges:
 - Charles University in Prague,
 - Heidelberg University,

- There is no scholarship, but virtual mobility is available. A Learning Agreement (LA) is required in any case

Blended Intensive Programmes (BIP)

- Erasmus Blended Intensive Programmes (BIP) are short forms of mixed mobility characterised by a mandatory **physical** and **virtual** component. The physical mobility can last from 5 to 30 days, depending on the programme.
- They are designed and implemented by at least three European universities. The physical component can be held at the University of Milan or at a host institution abroad.
- BIPs award a minimum of **3 ECTS** credits to participating students.

How to apply

- Throughout the year, the calls for Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Programmes (BIP) are published on the "Search for an international opportunity" page.
- Applications are submitted through the **Elixforms** platform indicated in the respective calls, along with the required documentation.
